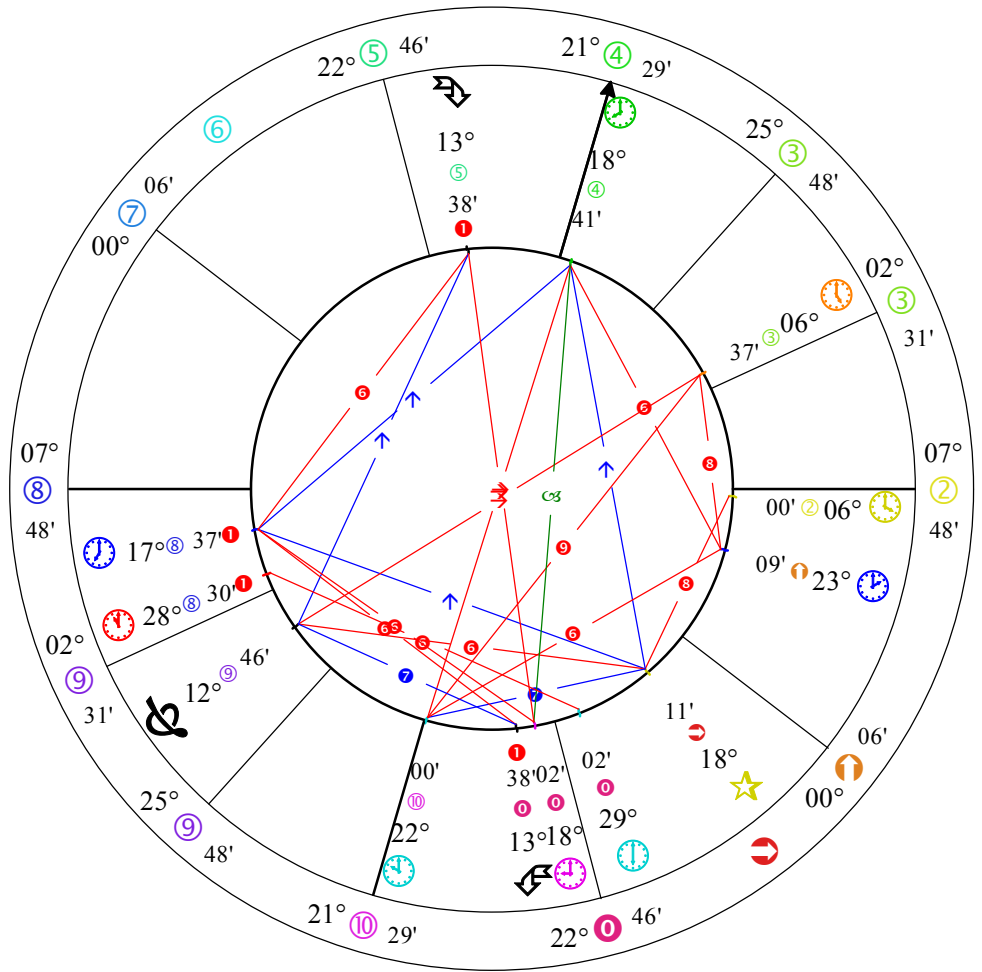

The Moon

The Moon tells you about your children's emotional nature and basic needs. It is also the key to how they experience intimacy in relationships. The Moon tells you about your children's relationship with their mother, how they experience their mother's nurturing. As a result it can also give you insights on how to best nurture your children as babies and maturing young adults. When a child feels safe and has their basic needs met, they are better able to achieve their goals later in life.

The Moon is in Aries

From the moment of birth young Bella makes her needs known. Baby Bella is restless, kicking and wriggling during most of the daily tasks such as bathing and changing nappies. This is a baby raring to go, demanding lots of attention and stimulation. With the Moon in the sign of Aries, young Bella needs plenty of time and space to develop her own interests as she grows up. On the one hand Bella may be introverted, asserting her independence from a young age, preferring to play on her own away from other children. Bella may be a quiet child enjoying her own company. On the other hand Bella may be more extroverted, a leader in the playground, enjoying the challenge of interacting with other children.

Before maturing Bella is likely to be bossy, either quietly and stubbornly asserting her will or loudly giving orders. Parents would do well to let Bella have some time on her own during times of stress. Activities such as bike riding, martial arts, kinder gym, and trampolines may be positive outlets for Bella's abundant energy. Appealing toys may include racing cars and balls, racquets, or anything associated with sporting activities.

The Moon is in the 5th House

Little Bella loves to play. She has strong emotions, which need an outlet, preferably activities that really help her to let off some steam. These could be simple games and other activities or perhaps she needs to express herself through a creative medium. Some children feel cherished when loved ones are paying them lots of attention, whereas others feel most loved when given the freedom to go their separate ways. Therefore gaining an understanding of the planet Venus in your child's chart can give you insights into how to encourage rewarding relationships with family and friends.

Venus is in Cancer

Bella thrives on love and affection. Parents can never give Bella too many cuddles or too much praise and tenderness. This little softie really enjoys feeling enfolded in the love of family and friends. A kind-hearted child, Bella tends to form close bonds with family members and perhaps a few selected friends. She doesn't want to stray far from home and enjoys helping loved ones with cooking and other kitchen duties. As Bella develops, she also enjoys relating to babies and younger children. She also benefits from the warmth and unconditional love of pets. In turn, pets benefit from Bella's need to nurture others. Soft and cuddly toys can comfort Bella in times of tension.

The key ingredient to successful relationships is how confident Bella feels within herself. The Sun

The Sun represents your child's identity. It describes your child's basic personality traits and their talents. It also tells you how your children think of themselves; how they need to express themselves; how they need to shine in their lives; how they feel alive. It is the centre of a child's self-expression. The Sun can also tell us about a child's father.

The Sun is in Taurus

The Taurus Sun child is both charming and reliable, thriving in a stable and ordered environment. Comfort plays an important role in Bella's daily life. Bella derives comfort from routine, thriving on the emotional security that accompanies familiar surroundings and a schedule. In fact once the routine has been established, Bella can be quite stubborn about adjusting to new circumstances. Adapting to change is difficult for this young Taurean. Bella also enjoys the sense of security that comes from being shown that she is well loved, particularly through the sense of touch. Bella is an attractive baby and child, who derives pleasure from the warmth of human contact. In fact physical comfort, pleasure and emotional warmth are the keystones needed in order for Bella to develop her talents.

Childcare, kindergarten and school should provide few problems for Bella, as long as the transition from home to institution is a gradual and comforting one. The Sun is in the 6th House

Mercury

Mercury is in Gemini

Mercury is in the 6th House

The Ascendant

The Ascendant, or Rising Sign as it's sometimes called, is considered to be an important component of an astrology chart. Ancient astrologers believed that the Ascendant depicted a person's primary motivation. Some believed that it was one of the links to discovering what makes a person happy. It could be said that when we're accomplishing our primary motivation then we're happy. By gaining knowledge of a child's Ascendant and discovering this child's primary motivation in life, parents and mentors can then help them achieve their goals. Caring adults can encourage the child with love and support. In turn your child experiences a sense of happiness and fulfilment.

The Ascendant is in Sagittarius

Bella is likely to actively seek her purpose in life, taking the initiative rather than waiting until circumstances are comfortable. Sagittarius is a Mutable sign denoting versatility, flexibility, adaptability, sensitivity, restlessness, indecision and anxiety. However, it is also a Fire sign depicting a need for action and enterprise.

As a baby Bella is easy going, enjoying the adventures of daily life. Bella enjoys plenty of stimulation. As a child, Bella is open-minded, honest, idealistic, jovial, impulsive and at times a deep thinker. Why and how questions are likely to abound, testing parents' knowledge. All being well this child views life as a continual adventure with many exciting lessons. She enjoys playing with other children and testing out the playground equipment. She also benefits from books. Bella's irrepressible enthusiasm is irresistible, and others are keen to join her adventures. At times Bella may be a little headstrong exhausting herself and her parents. However, Bella's primary motivation is for adventure and this needs to be encouraged within reason. Bella needs plenty of freedom to explore the wonders of the world into which she has been born.

Mars

Ambition and drive, like many traits, can be powerful positive forces in your children's lives, helping them achieve their dreams. Too much ambition can hinder your child's ability to collaborate. On the other hand, without motivation your child may not be able to establish a healthy sense of self and successfully leave home and family. Studying Mars, the planet of drive and energy, assists parents and mentors. Mars describes vitality in your child's birth

chart. If our children are free to pursue their own dreams and ambitions, their joie de vivre is a wonderful thing to see. By understanding the placement of Mars in your child's chart, you can help support their goals. You gain insight into whether or not your child lacks motivation in certain areas and why. You can also see if your child has an excess of passion. As a result you can either patiently try to motivate your child, or you can provide plenty of stimulation and direction.

Mars is in Pisces

The fiery energy of Mars does not mix well with water signs such as Pisces. This means that young Bella has difficulty achieving her objectives. She is easily sidetracked, daydreaming rather than staying on task. If Bella is left to her own devices then she enjoys a world of imagination and play, floating from one day to another. This may not be a problem for a young child at home but it creates difficulties as Bella matures and is faced with more responsibilities such as schoolwork and household chores. She finds any practical task a real challenge. Parents and mentors are likely to be frustrated by young Bella's carelessness but it is important not to be stern.

Parents and mentors need to help young Bella find a positive direction, gently teaching her the benefits of completing her objectives. This child needs plenty of understanding and support. Excess criticism could destroy Bella's self-confidence. She needs encouragement and praise for her abilities to be a sympathetic listener and an ingenious child. A creative pursuit such as learning to play a musical instrument or attending dance classes may provide an outlet for Bella's imagination as well as teaching her self-discipline. As she matures and leaves school, her unique skills are more appreciated and she is more able to achieve her goals.

Mars is in the 5th House

Bella loves to play. Fun is a major focus of her life. Parents and mentors need to ensure that early childhood is full of pleasure trips, games and social occasions. Otherwise young Bella could become bored, and perhaps despondent. She does not respond well to authoritarian discipline, but rather enjoys entertaining distractions. For this reason school could present a challenge with Bella finding it hard to settle down to a work schedule. However, all is well while Bella enjoys her schoolwork. Bella is creative and industrious in agreeable tasks, but once she loses interest projects are unlikely to be completed. Parents and mentors need to teach young Bella the pleasure that can be gained from completing a task, no matter how tedious it appears to be at times. Bella does not like being in one place for long periods of time. Therefore Bella fares better in an open school environment that encourages creativity and independence. Bella has strong likes and dislikes. She also has a strong reaction to peers, liking some friends, but intensely disliking others. Nevertheless she is likely to be a leader in the playground with her friends looking to her for direction. Bella does not necessarily enjoy this popularity, but is so busy going full steam ahead with her own fun-filled activities that others simply fall in line. This could prove to be a real talent in human resources later in life.

Childhood Journey

Wouldn't it be ideal if we could isolate one trait in our personalities, capture it in a glass for observation and dissection? Of course this is not possible. Neither is it possible for us to isolate one part of a birth chart. The different aspects of our children's birth charts intermingle in a complex manner to make the little person that we know and love. However, it is possible for us to influence the development of our children, to support them in their journey. The aim of this section is to give vital clues for parents and mentors on how to guide, but not coerce, the development of your child.

Jupiter is Trine The Moon

Bella is an amiable baby and a co-operative child. She finds pleasure in her relationship with her parents, in particular her mother or another mother figure in her young life. As a result young Bella is socially secure and feels that the world is a bountiful place. Bella enjoys pleasing other people, especially important women in her life. In return Bella receives much affection and many favours from mother or other significant women. Bella's optimistic outlook on life also attracts positive attention from other people. Social occasions are a joy with popular young Bella around. Friends and family members enjoy bestowing gifts. All in all life is pretty good for young Bella.

Bella is also likely to find emotional satisfaction from learning. As a result, she is self-motivated when it comes to her school work. This, of course, depends on other aspects of Bella's birth chart. However, it is likely that Bella finds life rewarding, passing with ease through each new stage of childhood with very little effort on the part of her parents.

Saturn is Trine The Moon

Bella needs lots of love and affection. She is a sensitive child, seemingly fated to struggle with at least one adversity in her young life. This could start when Bella is a baby. Perhaps she is born during a difficult time for either her mother or father or main caregiver. This could result in a lack of parental support for young Bella. While this is understandable it could be emotionally painful. On the other hand it is possible that Bella is a fretful baby, failing to thrive for a short period of time or she could be a shy youngster. Another possibility is that Bella sails through babyhood, but as a young child the family suffers a setback that affects young Bella. While this may be of some concern to parents, most challenges in life have a positive outcome. Whatever the challenging circumstances, young Bella initially may, despite the best parental intentions, feel insecure in her little world. Much of this depends on other influences in Bella's birth chart.

With other positive influences, Bella may be quietly confident and somewhat serious. Either way a firm and loving hand and a warm environment can help Bella overcome adversity and consequently feel secure and gain confidence. Adult caregivers need to avoid criticism, because Bella is more sensitive to harsh words than other children. Instead, parents need to do all that they can to boost Bella's self-esteem so that she can mature into a confident adult. As Bella matures, she overcomes adversity. She learns the advantages of hard work and self-discipline. The positive side to early-life difficulties is that Bella has the wisdom of experience, and outstrips other children in her achievements. This combination of the planet Saturn and the Moon is an important one in astrology. In some cases, it simply acts to tone down other influences in a child's birth chart. For instance, a fiery child may seem more introverted under this influence. For a full explanation of the likely outcome of this combination it is best to visit a qualified astrologer.

Neptune is Sextile The Moon

Bella is a soft, imaginative and sensitive child. She needs gentle handling and a calm environment in order to thrive. Baby Bella benefits from a peaceful and quiet home. If Bella has noisy siblings, then she benefits from her own quiet room, somewhere to escape the hustle and bustle of daily life. Lullabies are likely to be the best method of getting Bella off to sleep.

It is possible that young Bella shows signs of creative talents in one form of the arts such as music or dance. Alternatively she may be a kind and caring young person with an inclination to help others. Of course Bella could be both! she is particularly sensitive to the influence of one woman. This could be mother or grandmother, or a favourite aunt, teacher, nanny or caregiver. This woman is likely to be idolised by Bella and may have difficulty living up to her expectations. On the other hand this woman could also positively influence young Bella, teaching her in a gentle and loving manner and helping her reach her true potential. In babyhood and childhood Bella needs tender care, particularly by the women in her life.

Saturn is Square The Sun

Bella's relationship with her father plays an integral role in her life, probably from the moment of birth. It is even possible that young Bella has been named after her father or the father's family's name, or a close friend of her father, or that her father chose her name. Hence the bond starts at birth. This bond can be a positive one in the long term; however, it is possible that Bella's father is initially somewhat strict or oppressive. Perhaps he feels protective of young Bella, not realising that all young people need freedom to explore. Or perhaps he is simply a disciplinarian with difficulty expressing the love that is in his heart. Either way Bella is likely to feel limited in her self-expression as a child, particularly before the age of 14. As a result her self-esteem could suffer. She may be a serious and somewhat shy child. It is important that Bella's father, or father figure's in her life express a lot of praise and affection to help balance the discipline. This way Bella grows into a well-balanced young person, secure in the knowledge of her ability to achieve her goals with the support of important men in her life. She will have the self-discipline to succeed. In some cases it is not Bella's father that takes this stern role, but another adult male in her life. Therefore all of the above would apply to this man, not her father. It is also possible that problems can be experienced early in life because of Bella's relationship with her father or a father figure. If this is the case then it is likely that Bella will face these challenges, grow in wisdom and achieve success later in life, particularly from the age of 29 years.

Neptune is Square The Sun

Bella is a creative child, who longs for a close and caring relationship with her father or a man who can act as a father figure. Bella is also a sensitive child who needs gentle support by an important man in her life.
